GENERAL INFORMATION

Service is provided Monday – Friday, except the following major holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas

Seating is limited (up to 30 passengers). Priority is given to public assistance and other low-income residents commuting to/from work or work related activities. Call ahead for information.

There are no fares. Donations accepted.

The stop times listed in the schedule are approximate. However, the start times for each trip are firm.
Plan to arrive at your stop 3-5 minutes early.

Passengers will be picked up and discharged at all established bus stops. When circumstances permit, operators will stop at other locations along the route for passengers who hand signal.
Service animals and portable oxygen permitted.

No smoking. No drinking. No eating. No radio playing (without an earplug). No abusive language. No profanity. Conduct deviating from above rules will result in immediate expulsion from the bus. No pets except service animals.

This is a deviated fixed route. Passengers needing off-route pickup (up to ¼ of a mile from established route) must call the number below one day in advance. Requests will be honored as operating circumstances permit.

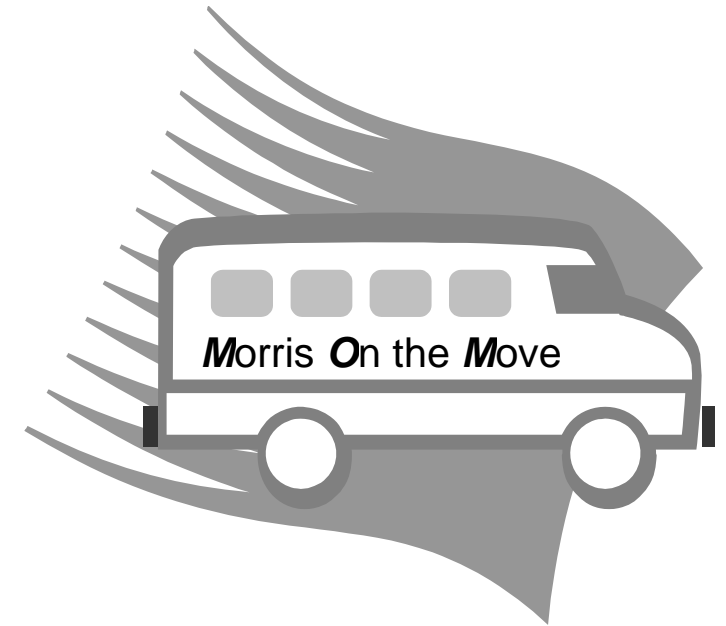
