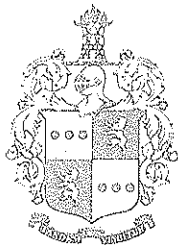


Dear Mr. Weinstein:






We request to meet with you to discuss alternatives.




